Provide certification and legalisation services on export and trade documents.

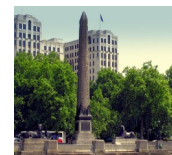
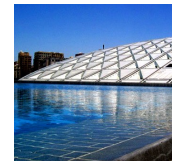
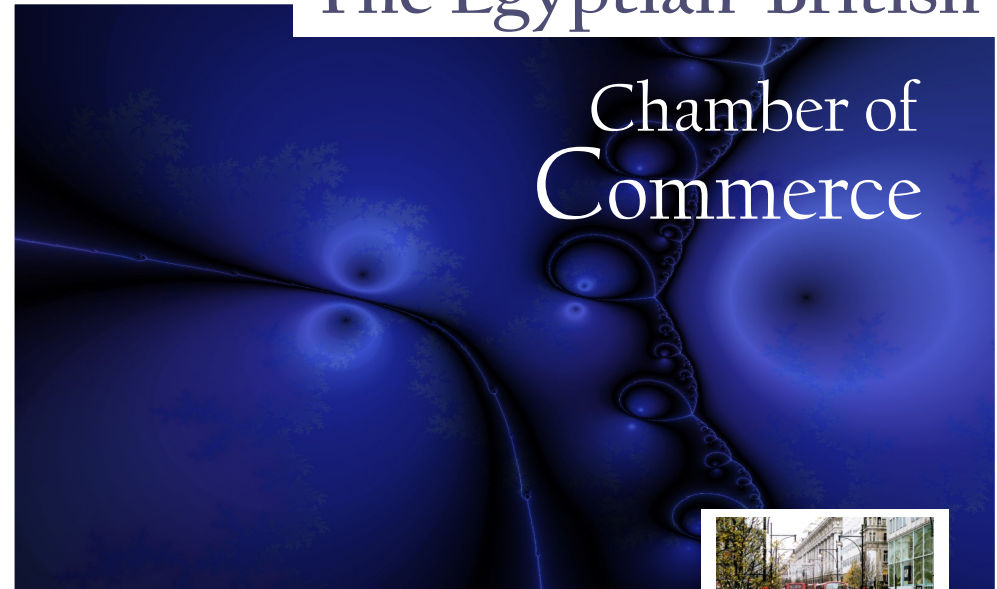
